Now he will give instruction regarding what it means to keep the law

All Of The Law Must Be Obeyed

Ignoring even a small part of the law will condemn - James 2:10-11 Must Exceed false righteousness Must move beyond outward focus on noticeable actions It is more than just what we say - Matthew 23:1-4 It is more than how we look/It is more than our actions - Matthew 23:5-7 It is not seeking a name for myself - Matthew 23:8-12 It is not making service hard - Matthew 23:13-15 It is not how much or what we devote to service - Matthew 23:16-22 It is not just getting the little/big things right - Matthew 23:23-24 It is not just the outside - Matthew 23:25-31 It is certainly not about riches - Luke 16:13-15

Exceeding Righteousness

This deals with attitude and action

Scribes & Pharisees excelled in making sure others saw what they did for God. It is leaving the world - Colossians 3:1-3; Matthew 6:24; 1Timothy 6:9-10; 1John 2:15-17 It is transformation - Romans 12:1-2 It is Christ in me - Galatians 2:20; Colossians 1:21-23; 2:6-7; 3:1-4 It is compassion/love for others Love conquers all - 1Corinthians 13:1-8 It is living our faith - James 2:14-17; 1John 2:4-6; 3:18 It is doing ALL the Will of God - Matthew 28:20; John 8:31-32; 2John 9
